School and Community

The British School Caracas (TBSC) is an intimate co-educational private international school, opening its' doors in September 1950, providing rigorous, quality education to local, expatriate families & diplomats. TBSC operated first as a Primary up to grade 6. Just Over ten years ago, TBSC expanded its academic offering to include high school, serving a total of 300 students. The class of 2022 will be our 8th HS graduating class. Many of our students are dual Venezuelan nationals with passport holders from over 40 countries. All staff members have significant English National Curriculum, IPC, IGCSE and IB experience and are recruited from the U.K, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, USA, EU and Venezuela.

Co-Curricular and Athletic Programmes

TBSC offers many personal enrichment activities such as student publications, performing arts clubs, gymnastics, Model United Nations, chess, cooking, origami, sports, photography, various musical activities and social events. Our students participate in interscholastic competitions with other international schools, as well as charity and community service projects, such as teaching English to local public-school students, visiting and working with orphanages, Children's Orthopedic Hospital and elderly peoples' homes, the Fundación TECHO, among others.

Timetable and Calendar

There are 185 teaching days in the year, starting in late August, finishing early July. The year is split into three terms. First term runs from August - December, second runs from January to mid-March, and third term runs from April - July.

COVID-19 Update - Graduating Class of 2021:

During their final year of IGCSE, strict quarantine restrictions were put in place beginning Friday, March 13th 2020; local authorities closed TBSC. Day's later students were alerted that the majority of their teachers would be taking a repatriation flight back to London for their safety. TBSC moved to remote, online instruction from April 2020 - June 2020 where there were no flights in or out of the country. During the first year of their rigorous International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, September 2020 to June 2021, TBSC trialed a hybrid approach, however the majority of this cohort's 1st year in IB remained remote with the added challenge of their multi-national teachers on different time zones around the globe. To add to this, a gas crisis hit the country during the summer and continues to be an added challenge, where one could not acquire petrol for weeks on end, with lines for fuel averaging 14 hours. This only added to the natural feelings of isolation and demotivation over the last 15 months without their teachers and community. Vaccine roll-out has been very slow in Venezuela, where loss of life due to COVID in the local and wider school-community has certainly been felt. Having been exposed to unrest and disruption throughout their lives, we believe our students have coped extremely well under these challenging circumstances. Beginning September 2021 our teachers have returned to Venezuela and TBSC has returned to physical on-site classes for the time being.

Class size As part of its Mission Statement, TBSC aims to keep class sizes small, to a maximum of 20 students per class. The teacher-pupil ratio is 1:13 in the Primary Section and 1:10 in the Secondary Section. This allows our teaching staff to monitor and observe student progress closely, with individualized attention for each child. Our class sizes also enhance our aim for a close knit, intimate and community- spirited atmosphere.
